CSnet's Role in Supporting Change

CSnet doesn't deliver Change Management services directly. Instead, we work closely with internal teams and expert partners like Jonathan to ensure that workers are supported throughout the transition.

Our implementation model includes:

- Experiential training before and after Go Live
- Intensive support for 8–12 weeks post Go Live
- Weekly drop-ins and one-on-one coaching
- Embedded on-screen guidance
- Monthly user groups for shared learning
